

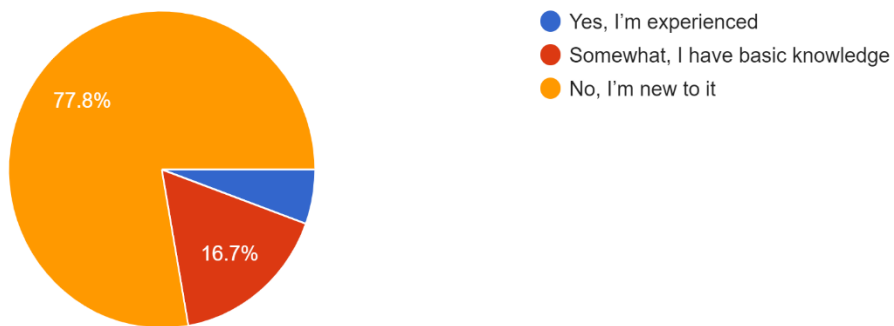

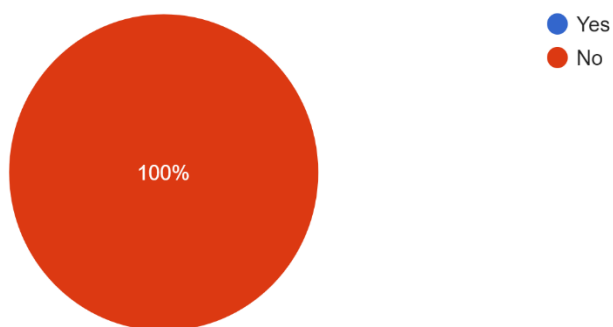
1. Do you have any experience with Lean Startup methodologies?

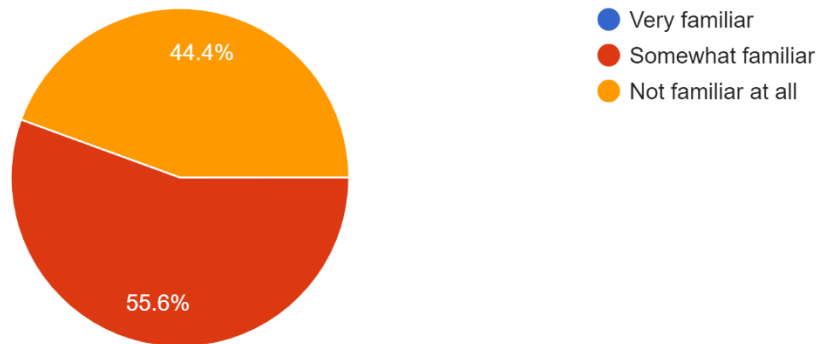

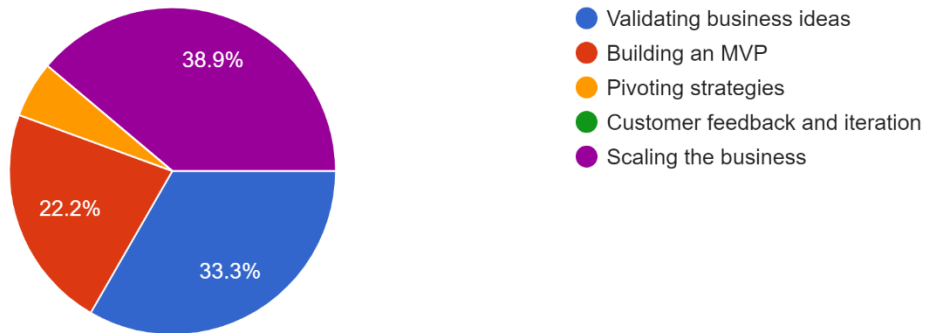

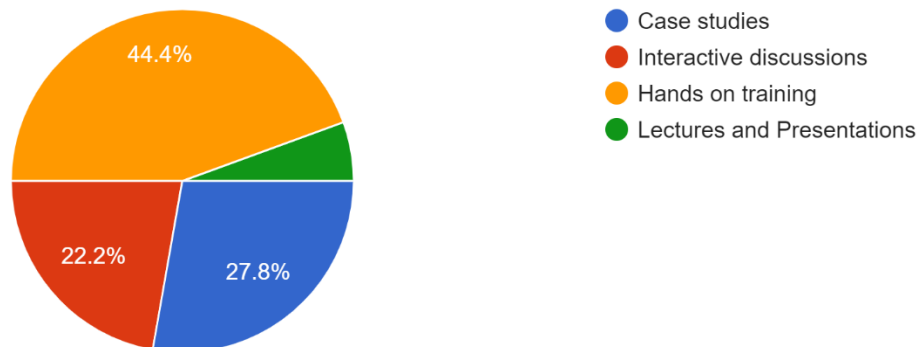
4. Which aspects of Lean Startup and MVP are you most interested in?

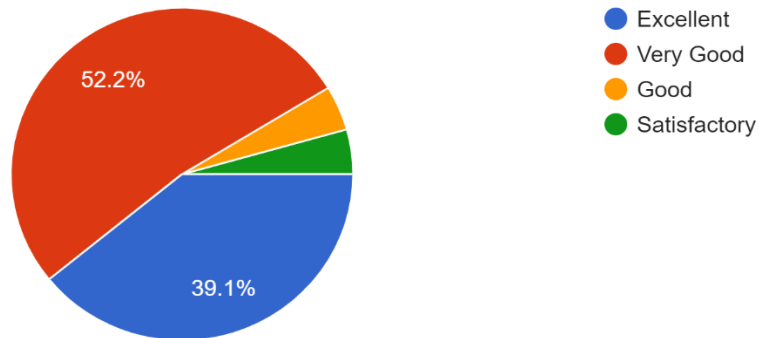

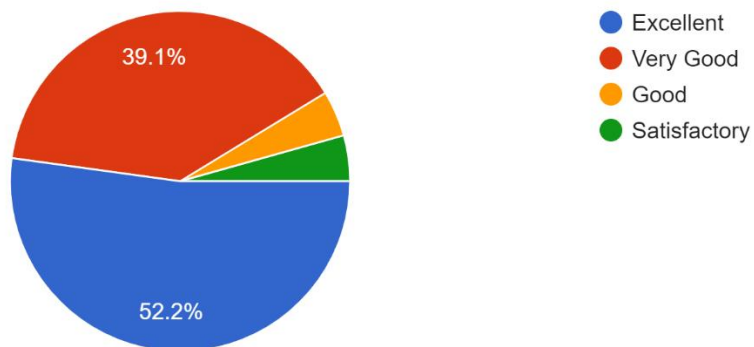

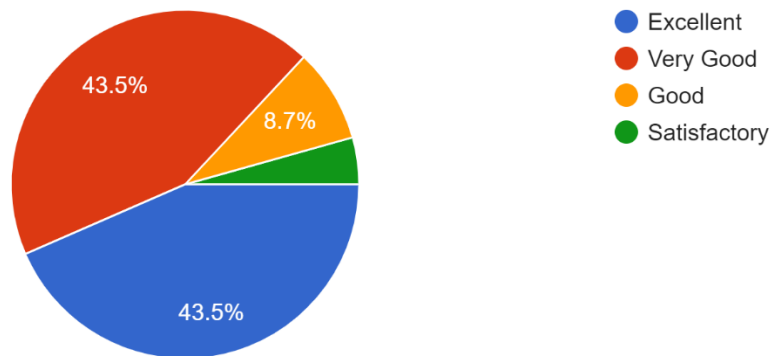

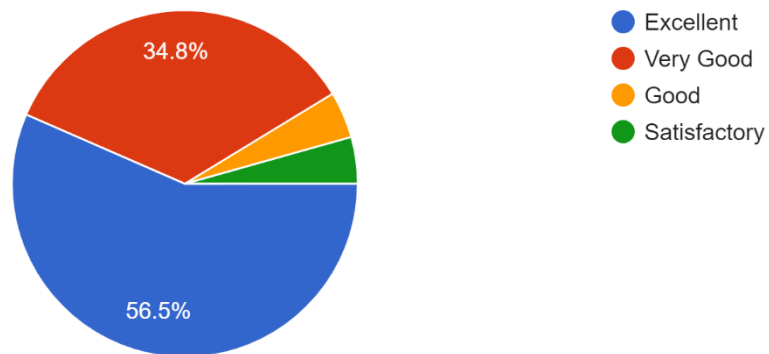

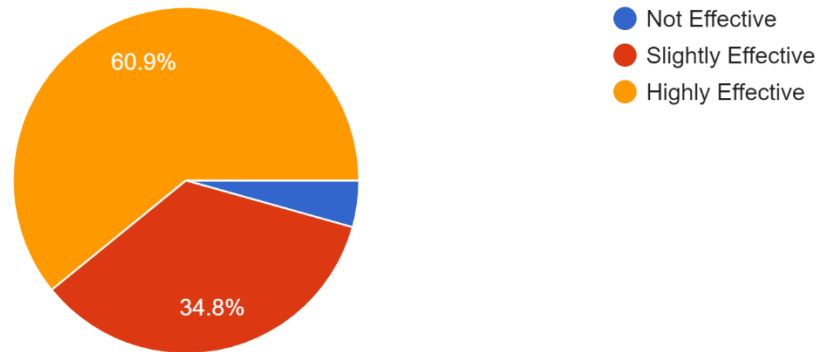

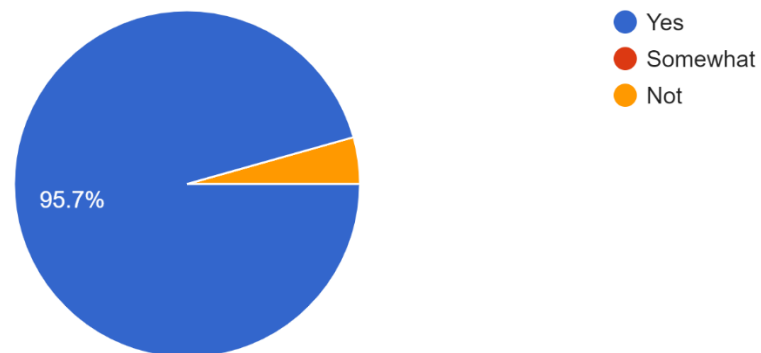
